



CWRT – Cookie Policy

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that Coventry & Warwickshire Reinvestment Trust Ltd (“CWRT” or “the Company”) are compliant with privacy laws like the GDPR and ePrivacy Directive, requiring transparent, and, in most cases, active consent from users.

2. Scope

Our cookie policy is a mandatory, transparent, and legally compliant document that informs website visitors about the types of cookies used, the data collected, the purpose of tracking, and how users can manage or disable these tracking preferences.

3. Types of Cookies

Cookies are small text files, containing letters and numbers, that websites store on a computer or mobile device to remember information about a website visit.

Our website uses cookies to distinguish users of our website. This helps us to provide users with a good experience when they browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

We use the following cookies:

Essential Cookies

These cookies enable core functionality such as security, verification of identity and network management. These cookies can't be disabled.

Marketing Cookies

These cookies may be used to track engagement with our website or communications and to measure the effectiveness of marketing activities where applicable. This helps us understand how people find and use our website and improve our communications.

Functional Cookies

These cookies collect data to remember choices users make to improve and give a more personalised experience.

Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us to understand how visitors interact with our website, discover errors and provide a better overall analytics.

4. Legal and Regulatory Requirements

CWRT uses cookies in accordance with the following legal and regulatory requirements:

- UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)
- Information Commissioner Office (ICO) regulatory requirements
- The Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR) requirements

5. Types of Cookies and Retention

Session Cookies: These expire as soon as you close your browser window. They are used for temporary tasks like keeping items in a shopping cart during one visit.

Persistent Cookies: These stay on your device until a specific expiration date, or until you delete them. These are used for "remember me" login features
